

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
PREUNIQUE INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED (PUIPL)
AND
KAVERI UNIVERSITY (KU)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter MoU) is made and entered into on this 1st day of June 2026, between the **Preunique India Private Limited (hereinafter PUIPL, FIRST PARTY)**, with CIN: U45500AP2019PTC111623 and having its corporate officer at Plot No: 26, Greenland Colony, Madhava Reddy Colony, Gachibowli, Hyderabad, Telangana 500032, on the ONE PART and Kaveri University having its head office at Gowraram (V), Wargal (M), Siddipet (D), Telangana 502279 (hereinafter KU, SECOND PARTY) on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter individually referred to as "PARTIES" .

Collective the above parties shall be referred as "The Parties" and individually as "PUIPL" & "KU"

ABOUT THE PARTIES

Where As:

Preunique India Private Limited is engaged in working in agriculture and allied sector especially in Oil Palm ecosystem. This includes, Nursery, Plantations, Processing Mills, Human Resources development, Trading etc in Oil Palm industry. PUIPL closely work with Oil Palm Plantations in Chhattisgarh and offer end to end Farmer Services. PUIPL is active in implementing NMEO-OP scheme in 15 districts in Chhattisgarh and its group company is active implementing in Telangana, Odisha and Gujarat.

Where As:

Kaveri University is dedicated to promoting higher education, research and extension activities in agriculture and allied sciences. The University emphasizes scientific innovation, skill development and sustainable agricultural advancement. It also focuses on strengthening academic, research and industry collaborations through technology transfer and capacity-building programmes. The University contributes towards rural development and socio-economic progress through quality education and research initiatives.

PURPOSE & SCOPE

This MoU is intended to build mutual cooperation between the parties to undertake collaborative activities in the areas of education, research, extension, skill development, technology transfer, establishment of Centres of Excellence (CoE), consultancy and



sustainable agricultural development. The objective is to work in the interest of farmers through action research, training programmes, studies, policy analysis, monitoring, evaluation, system development and technology dissemination in agriculture, horticulture and allied sectors for holistic and sustainable rural development.

RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS MoU

Both the parties have mutually agreed to

- I. Share their wide experience and ideas in their respective areas of activities through joint research, joint studies, faculty exchange and trainees/ student exchange in issues and areas related to soil testing and advisory services in the horticulture and allied sectors and to the holistic approach on sustainable development.
- II. Assist each other in advancement of systems development, technology development and action research in issues and areas related to innovative technology initiatives in the horticulture and allied sectors and to the holistic approach on sustainable development.
- III. Complement and supplement operations of facilities including those connected with advancement of training, action research, studies, consultancy, monitoring, evaluation, systems development and technology development in issues and areas related to Tele Agri and Advisory Services in the horticulture and allied sectors and to the holistic approach on sustainable development.
- IV. Make efforts to sponsor or to invite each other or to jointly operationalize for national and international institution building activities, training activities, research activities, studies, seminars, conferences and workshops.
- V. Collaborate and supplement utilization of resources and facilities on matters pertaining to formation of FPOs, PACS in the horticulture and allied sector with emphasis on Oil Palm Plantations in Telangana with focus on capacity building, training and skill development of stakeholders.
- VI. A separate Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) will be signed between the parties on specific activities of association and collaboration which will have clearly defined roles, responsibilities and deliverables with time lines.
- VII. PUIPL will provide technical support to KU, including all its Campuses/Institutions and the area under its jurisdiction, for the Oil Palm Development Program under NMEO-OP.
- VIII. PUIPL will abide to implement a buy-back system for fresh fruit bunches (FFBs) produced from KU on Government notified prices.

FUNDING



While expanding the areas of cooperation and helping each other to expand their areas of activities, both the parties will strive to bring more opportunities of financial support for achieving objectives in their respective domains.

ENTRY INTO EFFECT, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall valid for FOUR year and extendable up-to further FOUR years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each four-year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to four years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.
2. No amendment and modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.
3. This MoU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by the First party and the other by the Second party.
4. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed the MoU and represent that they approve, accept and agree to terms contained herein.
