

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

Agribridge India LLP (Krishivaas), Hyderabad

and

Kaveri University, Gowraram, Siddipet, Telangana

for facilitating

Precision Agriculture Research, Innovation, and Education

THIS AGREEMENT is made on this 30th day of July 2026 by and between:

AGRIBRIDGE INDIA LLP, a limited liability partnership incorporated under the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008, having its registered office at Plot No.265-H, Road no.10, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad, India (hereinafter referred to as "Krishivaas", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns), acting through its authorised signatory, Mr. Ram Bhoopal, of the First Part;

AND

Kaveri University, a Multidisciplinary Education and Research University established under the Telangana State Private Universities (Establishment and Regulation) (Amendment) Act No. 11 of 2018, having its headquarters at Gowraram, Wargal, Siddipet, Telangana, PIN – 502 279, India (hereinafter referred to as "KU", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors-in-interest and permitted assigns).

Each of Agribridge and KU are hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS:

- A. Agribridge owns and operates Krishivaas a remote sensing, satellite imagery, and artificial intelligence-driven precision agriculture platform that utilizes geospatial, agro-climatic, and earth-observation data to generate Derived Agricultural Intelligence ("DAI"), enabling real-time crop monitoring, predictive analytics, early warning systems, and decision-support services for farmers, institutions, governments, and other stakeholders across agricultural value chains;
- B. Kaveri University (KU) is a leading multidisciplinary institution with a strong focus on modern agriculture, integrating emerging technologies including AI, ML, IoT, Sensors, Robotics, Drones, and Blockchain relevant to agrifood systems, integrated farming systems, regenerative agriculture, and agriculture economics;

- C. The Parties have identified areas of mutual interest and are desirous of establishing a long-term collaborative relationship to promote research, innovation, capacity building, education, and knowledge exchange in the field of precision agriculture.

NOW THIS MoU WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Scope of Collaboration

Agribridge and KU intend to collaborate in relation to research, validation, testing, demonstration, capacity-building, and educational activities concerning the Krishivaas platform and its deployment, application, and use across farms, agricultural projects, and other initiatives associated with KU and its affiliates, partners, and stakeholders. The Parties may jointly identify and undertake specific projects, studies, pilot programmes, field trials, training initiatives, technology validation exercises, and other collaborative activities falling within the scope of this MoU.

The detailed scope, objectives, deliverables, timelines, responsibilities, funding arrangements, intellectual property rights, and other commercial terms applicable to any specific collaborative activity shall be mutually determined and documented in one or more separate written agreements, work orders, project charters, or statements of work executed by the Parties from time to time.

2. Precision Agriculture Innovation Hub (VIRTUAL)

As the cornerstone of this collaboration, the Parties propose to establish a virtual Precision Agriculture Innovation Hub ("Innovation Hub") as a platform for undertaking the collaborative activities contemplated under Clause 1 of this MoU. For the purposes of the Innovation Hub:

The specific scope, responsibilities, deliverables, timelines, funding arrangements, ownership of intellectual property, and commercialization rights in relation to any activity undertaken through the Innovation Hub shall be governed by separate written agreements executed between the Parties.

3. Forms of Cooperation

The cooperation between the Parties may take the following forms, among others:

- Exchange of data, knowledge, and information to facilitate joint projects
- Joint proposal submissions to national and international funding agencies
- Participation of scholars and faculty in conferences, symposia, and academic lectures
- Exchange programmes for scientists, researchers, and students
- Joint publicly-funded research projects
- Contract research under individually negotiated research and development agreements
- Smart farm enablement of KU-associated farmers on the Krishivaas platform
- Training and capacity-building workshops for students, faculty, and farmers
- Joint publication of research findings and knowledge dissemination
- Any other forms of collaboration mutually agreed upon in writing

The foregoing areas of cooperation are indicative and non-exhaustive in nature. The Parties may identify and undertake additional collaborative activities consistent with the objectives of this MoU, as may be mutually agreed upon in writing from time to time.

4. Terms of Cooperation

This MoU outlines the intent of the Parties to explore and collaborate on joint projects. It is expressly understood that this MoU is not legally binding and does not, in itself, establish enforceable rights or obligations with respect to specific projects. Any collaboration arising from this MoU will be governed by separate written project agreements mutually negotiated and signed by both Parties.

Each project agreement will define, among other things: (i) the scope and nature of the research and developmental activities; (ii) specific roles and responsibilities of each Party; (iii) terms relating to intellectual property rights; (iv) confidentiality and data protection; (v) financial arrangements and budget; (vi) liability and indemnification; and (vii) any other relevant terms and conditions.

Nothing contained in this MoU shall be construed as creating an obligation on either Party to disclose information, undertake any specific project, commit resources, enter into any definitive agreement, or continue discussions relating to any proposed collaboration. Any such commitment shall arise only upon the execution of a separate written agreement duly authorized by both Parties.

5. Intellectual Property Rights and Publications

5.1 Management of IP: Each Party shall retain ownership of its respective intellectual property existing prior to this MoU ("Background IP"). Agribridge shall retain

exclusive ownership of the Krishivaas platform, Proprietary Artificial Intelligence, Derived Agricultural Intelligence (DAI), and all related intellectual property, including any improvements, modifications, enhancements, updates, and derivative works thereto.

5.2 Project Intellectual Property: Any intellectual property jointly conceived, created, or developed by the Parties pursuant to a specific project under this MoU shall constitute Joint IP and shall be jointly owned by the Parties. For the avoidance of doubt, any improvements, modifications, enhancements, or derivative works relating to the Krishivaas platform, Proprietary Artificial Intelligence, DAI, or any other Background IP of Agribridge shall remain the exclusive property of Agribridge.

5.3 Publications: The Parties agree that results of activities undertaken under this MoU shall be published with due credit to all contributors. The publishing party shall be entirely responsible for the conclusions and interpretations reported. Prior written approval of both Parties shall be obtained before publication of any jointly generated data or results.

5.4 Use of Name and Logo: Neither Party shall use the name, logo, trademark, service mark, trade name, or other identifying marks of the other Party in any publication, publicity material, marketing communication, press release, website, social media communication, or public announcement without the prior written consent of the other Party

6. Confidentiality

6.1 For the purposes of this MoU, "Confidential Information" refers to any information disclosed by one Party to the other during the term of this MoU – whether orally, in writing, electronically, or in any other form – and explicitly designated as confidential at the time of disclosure.

6.2 The contracting Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any confidential Information received from the other Party. Such information shall be used solely for the purposes outlined in this MoU and all appropriate and reasonable measures shall be taken to prevent third parties from accessing such information.

6.3 The Parties shall hold in confidence all information marked as "Confidential Information" and disclosed by one Party to the other. They agree not to disclose such information to third parties, and only to release or disclose such information to individuals within the Party's organisation who are directly involved with the relevant project on a need-to-know basis.

6.4 The confidentiality obligations under this Article shall continue to be binding for a period of three (3) years after the termination or expiry of this MoU

7. Governance and Implementation Mechanism

7.1 The Parties shall work together in good faith to facilitate the implementation of the collaborative activities contemplated under this MoU and shall consult with each other on matters relating to its operation and review.

7.2 Representatives of the Parties may meet periodically, whether in person or virtually, to review ongoing activities, discuss opportunities for further collaboration, and exchange information regarding projects undertaken pursuant to this MoU.

7.3 Each Party shall designate a primary coordinator to act as the principal point of contact for matters relating to this MoU.

Either Party may replace its designated coordinator by providing written notice to the other Party.

8. Financial Arrangement

The Parties acknowledge that any financial arrangements relating to activities undertaken pursuant to this MoU shall be determined separately on a project-by-project basis and documented in the relevant project agreement. Such arrangements shall be subject to the availability of funds and the mutual agreement of the Parties.

Unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses incurred in connection with the discussions, negotiation, implementation, and performance of activities contemplated under this MoU.

9. General Provisions

9.1 Equal Opportunity: Both Parties subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste, or religion. Both institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this MoU.

9.2 Independent Contractors: The Parties are independent entities and nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, agency, employment, or fiduciary relationship between them.

9.3 Non-Exclusivity and Intellectual Property Protection: This MoU is non-exclusive in nature and either Party may enter into similar arrangements or collaborations with third parties. KU shall under no circumstance use, disclose, share, transfer reproduce, reverse engineer, , or permit any third party to access or use the intellectual property, Confidential Information, proprietary technology, data, know-

how, or trade secrets of Agribridge or generated through the Krishivaas Platform . Agribridge shall retain exclusive ownership of the Krishivaas platform, Proprietary Artificial Intelligence, Derived Agricultural Intelligence (DAI), and all related intellectual property rights.

9.4 Entire Agreement: This MoU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and may not be amended or modified except by a written instrument signed by both Parties.

9.5 Severability: The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this MoU shall not affect the other provisions hereof, and this MoU shall be construed as if such invalid or unenforceable provision were omitted.

9.6 Notices: Any notices required under this MoU shall be in writing and sent by registered post, courier, or electronic mail to the respective Party at the addresses set out in this MoU or as updated from time to time.

9.7 No Commitment to Proceed: Nothing in this MoU shall obligate either Party to enter into any specific project, transaction, or definitive agreement. Any such arrangement shall be subject to separate written agreement between the Parties.

10. Effective date, Renewal and Termination

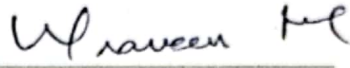
10.1 This MoU shall enter into force on the date of the last signature affixed hereto ("Effective Date") and shall remain valid for an initial period of three (3) years. This MoU may be extended by the mutual written consent of the Parties.

10.2 This MoU may be terminated by either Party by giving written notice to the other Party at least three (3) months in advance of the stated termination date. Termination of this MoU shall not affect activities in progress pursuant to specific project agreements, which shall continue until concluded by the Parties in accordance with their terms.

10.3 This MoU may be amended only by the written consent of both Parties.

10.4 The termination or expiry of this MoU shall not affect any rights or obligations intended to survive termination, including those relating to intellectual property, confidentiality, publications, and use of name and logo
